
#### MARKOV CHAIN game

- 1. We create a database; each word is an entry and takes the following word as a possible value. The entry for 'ruidoso' will have four values:
  - 1. y 2. con 3. . 4. ,
- 2. Once the database is created, we choose a starting word for a new text, for ex. Aire.




